



# AARHUS DANCE EXCELLENCE

## Terms & Conditions

### ENGLISH VERSION

#### **Art. 1 – Organisation**

Aarhus Dance Excellence is an intensive ballet training programme organised by In The Middle. The event takes place in Aarhus, Denmark, from 12–14 October 2026 at STUB 4, Brobjergskolen Cultural Center.

#### **Art. 2 – Programme Structure**

The programme consists of one intensive course divided into two age groups.

Group 1 (Ages 12–14): 90 min Classical Ballet, 60 min 4Pointe Workshop, 90 min Repertoire & Variations.

Group 2 (Ages 15+): 90 min Classical Ballet, 75 min 4Pointe Workshop, 90 min Repertoire & Variations.

Faculty: Lynne Charles and Damiano Pettenella.

#### **Art. 3 – Participation Requirements**

Participation is open to dancers aged 12 and above. Participants will be assigned to the appropriate group according to age. The organisation may request photographic or video material and reserves the right to select participants.

#### **Art. 4 – Registration**

Applicants must complete the online registration form, await confirmation and proceed with payment according to the indicated instructions. Registration becomes valid only after payment has been received.

#### **Art. 5 – Fees and Payments**

Programme Fee: 2,990 DKK per participant. Any bank charges or online platform fees may be added. The fee includes all scheduled classes and activities but does not include accommodation, meals, transport or personal insurance.

#### **Art. 6 – Scholarships, Auditions and Direct Admission**

For the first time in Denmark, participants will have the opportunity to work directly with Lynne Charles, Director of English National Ballet School and creator of the internationally renowned 4Pointe Method. Scholarships, audition invitations and direct admission opportunities may be awarded. Eligible dancers may also be considered through the intensive for English National Ballet School opportunities.

#### **Art. 7 – Places Available**

Places are limited. The organisation may close registrations early, create waiting lists and

reorganise groups if necessary.

**Art. 8 – Cancellations and Refunds**

Payments are non-refundable unless otherwise communicated by the organisation. In the event of cancellation by the organisation, refund or credit procedures will be communicated.

**Art. 9 – Programme Changes**

Changes to teachers, schedules, venue or content may occur due to organisational needs or force majeure. If the event is cancelled due to force majeure or insufficient registrations, payments made will be refunded. Travel expenses and banking fees cannot be refunded.

**Art. 10 – Code of Conduct**

Participants must respect facilities, schedules, staff, fellow participants and equipment. The organisation may exclude anyone who does not comply with the rules without refund.

**Art. 11 – Liability and Health**

Participants declare adequate physical and mental fitness. The organisation is not responsible for injuries, damages, theft or loss of personal belongings. Personal insurance is recommended.

**Art. 12 – Clothing**

Appropriate ballet attire is required, including pointe shoes where applicable.

**Art. 13 – Use of Images**

Photos and videos taken during the event may be used for promotional and documentary purposes unless a written objection is submitted before the beginning of activities.

**Art. 14 – Privacy**

Personal data will be processed in compliance with applicable legislation and used exclusively for organisational purposes related to the event.

**Art. 15 – Acceptance**

Submitting the registration form implies full acceptance of these terms and conditions.

**Art. 16 – Deadlines and Communications**

Applications remain open until all places are filled. Acceptance notifications and payment deadlines will be communicated by the organisation.

#### **Art. 1 – Organisation**

Aarhus Dance Excellence er et intensivt balletprogram organiseret af In The Middle. Arrangementet finder sted i Aarhus, Danmark, fra 12.–14. oktober 2026 i STUB 4, Brobjergskolen Kulturcenter.

#### **Art. 2 – Programstruktur**

Programmet består af ét intensivt kursus opdelt i to aldersgrupper.

Gruppe 1 (12–14 år): 90 min klassisk ballet, 60 min 4Pointe Workshop, 90 min repertoire og variationer.

Gruppe 2 (15+ år): 90 min klassisk ballet, 75 min 4Pointe Workshop, 90 min repertoire og variationer.

Undervisere: Lynne Charles og Damiano Pettenella.

#### **Art. 3 – Deltagelseskrav**

Deltagelse er åben for dansere fra 12 år og opefter. Deltagerne placeres i den relevante aldersgruppe. Organisationens kan anmode om foto- eller videomateriale og forbeholder sig retten til at udvælge deltagere.

#### **Art. 4 – Tilmelding**

Ansøgere skal udfylde onlineformularen, afvente bekræftelse og gennemføre betaling i henhold til de angivne instruktioner. Tilmeldingen er først gyldig efter modtaget betaling.

#### **Art. 5 – Gebyrer og Betaling**

Programgebyr: 2.990 DKK pr. deltager. Gebyret omfatter alle planlagte undervisningsaktiviteter, men ikke kost, logi, transport eller personlig forsikring.

#### **Art. 6 – Stipendier, Auditions og Direkte Optagelse**

For første gang i Danmark får deltagerne mulighed for at arbejde direkte med Lynne Charles, direktør for English National Ballet School og skaberen af den internationalt anerkendte 4Pointe-metode. Udvalgte dansere kan modtage stipendier, auditions og direkte optagelsesmuligheder.

#### **Art. 7–16**

Regler vedrørende pladser, aflysninger, programændringer, adfærd, ansvar, påklædning, brug af billeder, databeskyttelse, accept og kommunikation følger de samme principper som beskrevet i den engelske version.
